## RE-ENTRY COURT (REEC) INTAKE PROCESS


## POTENTIAL PARTICIPANTS ARE IDENTIFIED AND REFERRED:

- 1) Self-Referral Application available in prison; Program Orientation conducted by REEC
- 2) During Post Sentence Investigation (PSI)
- 3) At Sentencing / Probation Violation Hearing
- 4) Original Sentencing Judge (or attorney) can refer to REEC when filing a Motion for Judicial Release

Applications can be submitted to REEC via the offender, defense counsel or the Original Sentencing Judge


REEC reviews applications to determine initial eligibility

- REEC Judge reviews case to decide if defendant is eligible for REEC.
- If eligible, REEC Judge orders defense to file the motion, apprises Original Sentencing Judge of eligibility/acceptance/request for REEC.
- Original Sentencing Judge can transfer jurisdiction to REEC Judge at this point or at conclusion of Judicial Release Hearing.
