We are committed to the health and safety of our community, visitors and employees. In an effort to best mitigate the spread of Coronavirus, the following questions **MUST** be asked of **Every Individual entering** each facility entry point (Staff, General Public, etc.)

Individual Entry Access must be **denied** if **either** of the following occur:

- 1) The entering individual has a fever, specifically of 100.4 degrees or above
- 2) The entering individual answers "YES" to ANY of the questions below.

Do you have any of the following symptoms? (Screener: Please ask these one by one and wait for the individual's response before moving to the next)

- Do you have a New Dry Cough that has only begun in the last 2 to 3 days?
- Do you have New Shortness of breath and only recently occurring?
- Are you Experiencing New Fatigue/Tiredness that is only recently onset in the last 2 to 3 days?
- Do you believe you have a fever or have you had recent chills? (*Person with fever of 100.4 or above must be DENIED access.*)
- Have you been in contact with anyone who has known or suspected to have COVID-19?

*If the screener is unable to determine whether an individual should be granted entry based on their response(s), the Screeners should call the hotline staffed 24/7 by MetroHealth Hospital Staff for Coronavirus support while making their determination. Additionally, the State of Ohio line is being provided for the same reason.

*Once an individual is approved site access, they should be given a Wristband and asked it to be placed on their wrist Immediately, prior to walking into the building. ANYONE seen within a County Building without a Wristband with the appropriate daily color must be asked to immediately leave the building.

Each day, or within every 24-hour period, a new color wristband will be required for entry. **After every 24-hour period lapses, EVERY individual will need to be completely rescreened**, and given the updated wristband to re-enter the building.

Conditions continue to change, and we will adjust as we need to in order to respond the best we can.
